PARISH REPAIRS - an update - Thank you very much to those who attended the two Parish meetings in Selby last weekend. As was explained, the recent report highlighted all of the work required across our two Churches. This has been prioritised and whilst there are some smaller tasks to be carried out in Carlton, the most pressing issue is the south nave roof (nearest the road) on the church in Selby. After grants, which the Diocese will apply for on our behalf, and some funds we have in the bank, we will need to raise approximately £40,000 over the next 18 months. The majority view of those present at the meetings was to go ahead with the project and commit to the fund-raising. A list of the questions asked and answers given can be found on the notice-board. Thank you to all who have expressed a willingness to get involved.
